Tournament Rules and Guidelines

1. Must Pre-Pay and Pre-Enter. Must enter online.

2. Novice is not an age group. Novice is any FIRST or SECOND year wrestler. If you have wrestled only one match in a season, it counts as a full year.

3. Novice eligibility protests must be made by the end of weigh in.

4. All age protests must be made before the weigh-in session has completed.

5. Birth certificates must be available if requested by a tournament director.

6. Protest Fee: \$100 All protests must be paid to a tournament director. If your protest is found to be valid, the protest fee will be returned.

7. Wrestler must make weight in singlet. Both pieces of a doublet are required for weigh in.

8. Hair cover and mouth guard, if required, must be with wrestler at weigh-in.

9. Hair code, skin check & fingernails will be enforced by referees. Skin conditions, if required, must be on a National Federation medical release form and dated within 10 days of event.

10. Coaches' passes and/or floor passes must be visible. Press or Media passes must be pre-approved prior to entry. Proper vest and press credentials must be worn and may not sit in the coaches' seat as a coach.

11. Must register with exact team name to compete for team awards and to receive Coaches' Passes. Changes will not be made after registration.

12. Total number of Coaches' FREE Coaches Passes determined by the number of entries:

a. 0 - 2 = 0
b. 3 - 5 wrestlers=1 coach pass;
c. 6 - 10 wrestlers=2 Coaches' passes;
d. 11 - 16 wrestlers=3 Coaches' Passes;
e. 17+ = 4 passes;
Additional passes available for purchase.

13. Open Time periods are as follows: 6 and under: 1-1-1 8,10,12, 15 and under: 1 ½-1 ½-1 ½ Girls time periods are as follows: 7 and under: 1-1-1 9,12, 15 and under: 1 1/2--1 1/2--1 1/2 All Consolation matches: 1-1-1. Novice tournament: 1-1-1; Medal matches are the same as championship rounds.

14. Round Robin ties – 1st criteria will be most wins, 2nd criteria is most falls, 3rd criteria is head to head. Any exhibition matches do not count toward any awards.

15. Minimum rest between matches and maximum number of matches not in effect. Exception: If requested, 6 and under through 15 and under will have a 10 minute rest between matches.

16. Overtime matches will comply with the Federation of High School Rules.

17. Outstanding award – based on Champion with the most falls in the least amount of time.

18. Must be present to win any awards.

19. We reserve the right to make changes to the schedule and as necessary. If any changes are made, they will be posted in the arena and on social media.

20. Child abuse, abusive language, disorderly conduct, etc., will not be tolerated and will be dealt with severely.
